About Us

The Jack Leslie Youth Environment Grant

is a creative partnership between Child and Youth Friendly Calgary (CYFC), The City of Calgary, and the Leslie Family. The grant recognizes the positive impact Jack Leslie, former Mayor of Calgary, made to the city and the environment.

Initiated by two programs of CYFC, the Mayor's Youth Council and the Calgary Youth Foundation, The Jack Leslie Youth Environment Grant recognizes Mr. Leslie's achievements and encourages youth in Calgary to continue his efforts.

Eligibility

Projects must:

- be located in Calgary
- directly benefit the environment in Calgary
- be planned and implemented by youth

Our Grants

- We fund projects that have a positive impact on the environment in The City of Calgary
- We fund youth initiated and youth driven projects for youth in grades 7 to 12
- We fund one project conducted by an individual up to \$500
- We fund two projects conducted by a group or organization up to \$1000 each
- We do not fund for-profit ventures, projects that will later pass on our to other organizations or charities, conference fees or tuition costs for individuals or groups

About You

You may submit your application by submitting a two page description of your project with the following information:

Title Page

- Name of group or organization
- Name of project
- Contact name, address, phone number, email and fax number
- Amount requested (up to \$500 for an individual, \$1000 for a group)

Project Description

- Less is MORE! Please keep your description to two pages or less.
- What are you planning to accomplish?
How will you accomplish your goals?
- How does your project have a positive impact on the environment?
- How are youth involved in the planning and running of the project?
- What is the timetable for your project? What happens when?
- What outcomes are you expecting? How will you measure your success?

Budget

- What will it cost to do what you want to do?
- Proposed budget including income and expenses

Projects must be completed by January 1, 2011. We would like to acknowledge your accomplishments during the 2011 Mayor's Environment Expo. Therefore we would appreciate receiving a creative illustration of the project's accomplishments by February 1, 2011.
